



Fierce Reality



The Bible explains that the problem is; humanity turned away from God, just like a rebellious child turns away from a wonderful parent, and because of that, the world got broken.



If you have prayed this prayer, you have opened your heart to the One who completely understands suffering and fully understands you— and who always has. You can now start a lifetime of knowing Him and being with Him, you are finally home.






Remember, He is your place of peace ...
